PREVENTION AND PROHIBITION OF SEXUAL HARASSMENT RULES

With regard to the Supreme Court judgement and Guidelines issued in 1997 to provide for the effective enforcement of the basic human right of gender equality and guarantee against sexual harassment abuse more particularly against issued circulars since 1998 to all the universities, advising them to establish harassment, violence against women and ragging at the universities and colleges. It has further advised the universities to be proactive by developing a conductive atmosphere on the campus, where the status of women is respected and they are treated with.

Keeping the UGC and The Supreme Court Guidelines in view, JVIT College has constituted a committee against sexual harassment to provide a healthy and congenial atmosphere to the staff and students of the college.

Some examples of behavior that constitute Sexual Harassment at the College:

- · Making sexually suggestive remarks or innuendos.
- Serious or repeated offensive remarks, such as teasing related to person's body or appearance.
- Offensive comments or jokes.
- Inappropriate questions, suggestions or remarks about a person's sex life.
- · Displaying sexist or other offensive pictures, posters, mms, sms, whatsapp, or e-mails.
- Intimidation, threats, blackmail around sexual favours.
- Threats, intimidation or retaliation against an employee who speaks up about unwelcome behavior with sexual overtones.
- · Unwelcome social invitations, with sexual overtones commonly understood as flirting.
- Unwelcome sexual advances which may or may not be accompanied by promises or threats, explicit or implicit.
- Physical contact such as touching or pinching.
- · Caressing, kissing or fondling someone against her will (could be considered assault).
- Invasion of personal space (getting too close for no reason, brushing against or cornering someone).
- · Persistently asking someone out, despite being turned down.
- Stalking an individual.
- Abuse of authority or power to threaten a person's job or undermine her performance against sexual favours.
- Falsely accusing and undermining a person behind closed doors for sexual favours.
- Controlling a person's reputation by rumour-mongering about her private life.
